

2019 Schroeder Award

Presented at the annual conference, the W.R. "Bill" Schroeder Distinguished Service Award is the highest honor presented by the International Sports Heritage Association (ISHA) to recognize distinguished achievement in the field of sports heritage. To be considered, individuals must have made a significant contribution of a lasting nature to a sports museum or hall of fame. Recipients should demonstrate accomplishment in their role and a record of service to the profession on a local, regional, national, and/or international level. Recipients should also have a proven record of service to the community in which the organization is located.

History:

The W.R. "Bill" Schroeder Award was first awarded in 1985 in recognition of Bill Schroeder's pioneering contributions in the development of sports museums and halls of fame and as a founding father, past president and past secretary of the Association of Sports Museums and Halls of Fame (a predecessor of ISHA).

Eligibility Requirements:

To be considered, individuals must have:

- Made a significant contribution of a lasting nature to the field of sports heritage.
- Be actively involved or retired from an ISHA member institution.

The Schroeder Award Committee, which consists of a Board Member and several past Schroeder Award Recipients, reviews potential candidates on a yearly basis and may present a nomination for approval by the Board of Directors.
